Pinebrook Family Answers (PBFA) is committed to respecting the privacy of donors. The types of donor information that it collects and maintains are as follows:

- Contact information: name, address, telephone number and email address
- Giving information
- Information on events attended, publications received and special requests for program information
- Information provided by the donor in the form of comments and suggestions

Pinebrook Family Answers uses donors' information to understand their interests in its mission and to update them on the organization's plans and activities. It is shared with staff, board members, volunteers and consultants only on a "need-to-know" basis.

Disclosure of Personal Information

Secure Credit Card Transactions

When you contribute to PBFA, we ask you for the following information: name, address, phone number, e-mail address, and sometimes credit card. This information is used to process your order and if necessary, to contact you for help when we are processing the donation. PBFA does not store your information when the transaction is approved.

Cookies

www.pbfalv.org uses "cookie" messages to automatically help provide better services. They remind us who you are and your preferences for our website based on what you've done and told us before. The "cookie" is placed in your computer and is read when you come back to our website. Cookies let us take you to the information and features you're particularly interested in. They also let us track your usage of www.pbfalv.org, so we know which parts of our sites are most popular. You can reject cookies or cancel them by instructing your Web browser accordingly.

Social Media Widgets

Our Site may include social media tools, including social media widgets or plug-ins, to connect you to your social media accounts. These features may set a cookie or use other automatic collection and tracking technologies to collect information about you and your use of the social media features through and in connection with our Site. These social media tools may be hosted by a third party. Your interactions with these tools and the corresponding social media platforms are governed by the privacy policies of the companies.

Our Commitment To Children's Privacy

PBFA does not collect or maintain information at our website from people we actually know are under 18. If we learn that a user is under 18 years of age, PBFA will promptly delete any Personal Information that the individual has provided to us.
